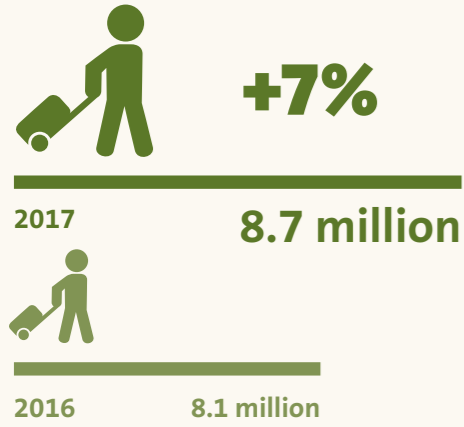


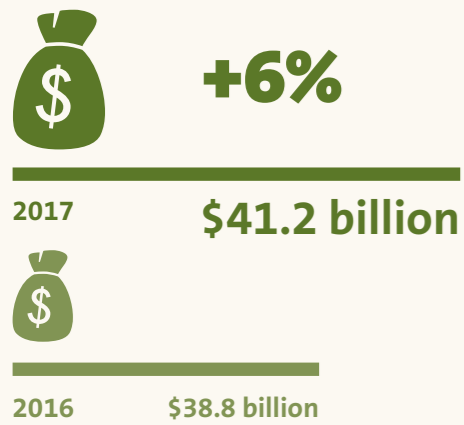
International Tourism Snapshot as at 30 September 2017

We welcomed 8.7 million international visitors as at year ending September 2017. These visitors injected \$41.2 billion into the Australian economy. Total international aviation capacity to Australia grew by 6 per cent.

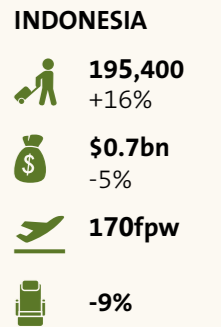
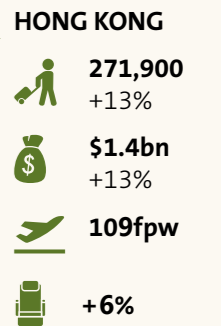
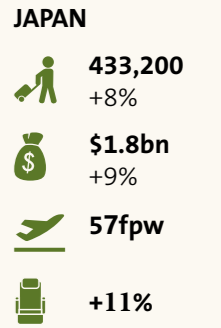
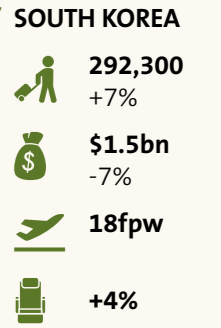
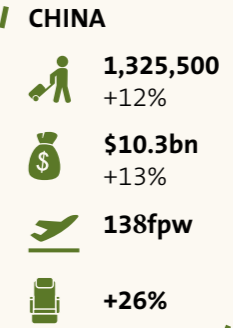
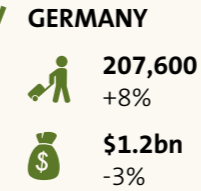
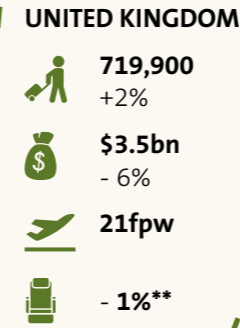
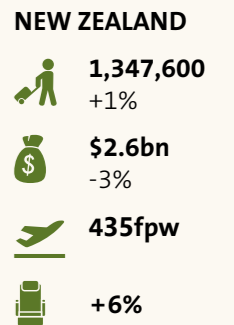
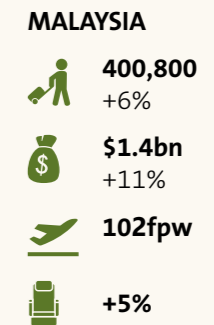
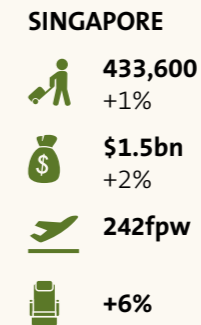
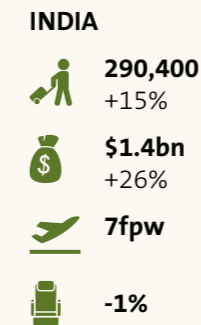
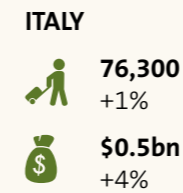
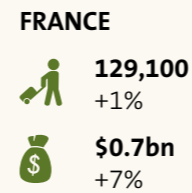
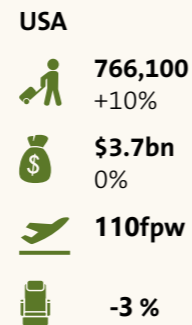
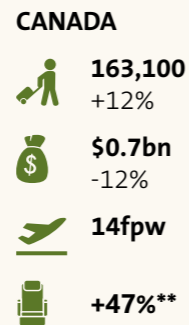
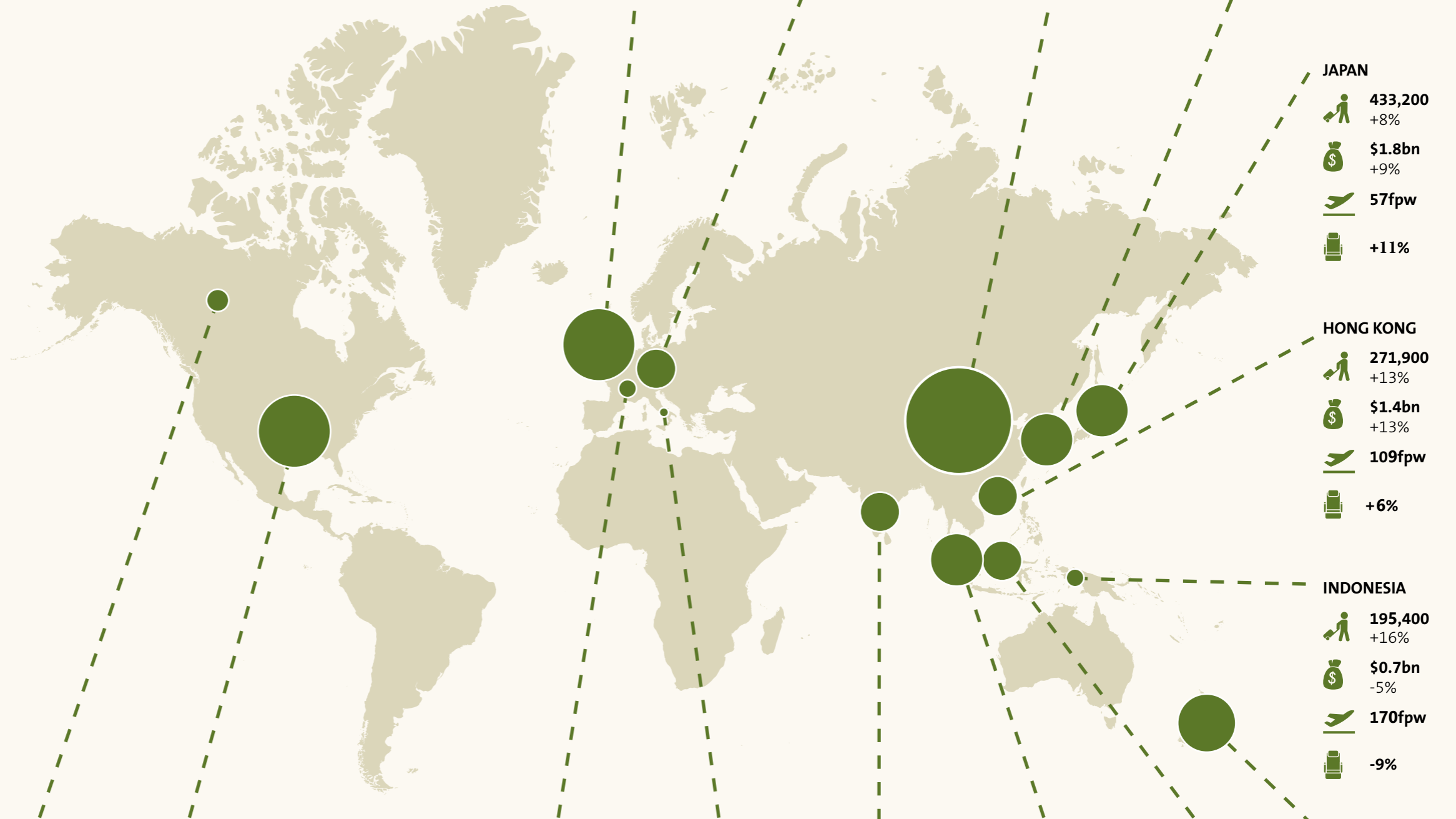
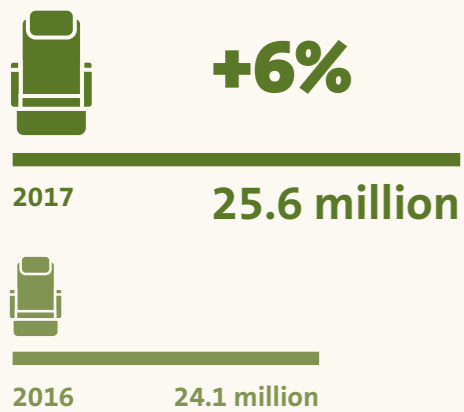
Total international arrivals to Australia
